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# Financial Information

OneWorld accepts cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, or Discover, most forms of insurance, Medicare and Medicaid. Fees are due at the time of service and based on household size and income. For people without insurance or very high deductibles, charges are based on a sliding fee scale. Proof of one month's income is required to determine fees. The following nominal fee or sliding fee scale is based on the Federal Poverty Guidelines for 2019.
